



1. Don't carry your Social Security card on you or write it on your checks. Only provide your SSN when absolutely necessary and required.



2. Protect your PIN. Never write a PIN on a credit/debit card or on a slip of paper kept in your wallet.



- **3. Watch out for "shoulder surfers".** Use your free hand to shield the keypad when using checkout key pads and ATMs.
- **4. Keep your receipts.** Promptly compare receipts with account statements.
